Full membership:	€	145
Recent academy graduate:	€	105
65+ senior membership:	€	80
Partner membership:	€	105
Student membership:	€	25 (no right to vote)

New applications as well as ending the membership during the running calendar year will be registered at the first of the next quarter. It's possible to pay in terms (per six months/ per quarter).

During the first year you are entitled to a 40 euro reduction if you have full membership and an unemployment benefit level income. Please notify us on the application form.

Recent academy graduates tariffs are 105 euro during the first 2 years after graduation, after this period you will be listed as full member.

Student membership a 25 euro is possible until the age of 27. Students over the age of 27 cannot apply for student membership. Student members need to present (valid) proof of registration at an academy of arts or an ov-jaarkaart (annual commutation ticket for public transport).

After registering, the membership card and a giro card for contribution will be sent for the running calendar year.

Members can choose between service A) services without surcharge and service B) services with surcharge for membership advantages such as reductions and advisory services. For issues concerning legal assistance, legal assistance statutes apply.

Members receive a free copy of the BBK-paper, which is issued 6 times a year.

A subscription to the BBK-Krant (BBK-Paper) only costs 20 euro. Membership advantages are listed on our website and in the BBK-Krant (BBK-Paper).

Tax return via the BBK

The BBK employs two all round tax consultants fully specialised in expressive arts and the tax collectors office.

As a BBK-member you can make an appointment (at our national bureau in Amsterdam) with our consultants to help you with your tax return.

The BBK makes use of the respite regulation for tax consultants, implying that a collective respite is urged for all members listed in our tax return registration.

The main advantage of this respite regulation is the spreading of the tax returns over the year. It's impossible for our consultants to handle all tax returns before April first.

Without saying, artists making use of WWIK or other regulations requiring an early copy of their tax return are taken into account.

Members (and partners) who make use of our help **for the first time** need to make an appointment **before March 15** in order to make use of the collective respite regulation if not they will have to apply for respite themselves.

Individual respite has to be requested before April first and will mostly be granted until July first of the same calendar year.

In some cases it's possible to send us your data so our tax consultants can take care of your tax return.

The costs for a regular tax return including estimation form are 60 euros.

In case of complex tax returns the costs will be determined after consultation.

Administration

If a tax return appointment is made we assume an overall orderly administration of the artist, which unfortunately is not always the case.

An unorderedly administration can result in unnecessary high consultant tax return costs.

For this reason the BBK regularly offers the course "Administratie ook een kunst" (The art of administration), a guideline for starting up and maintaining (simple) VAT bookkeeping/administration. Including a "how to do" your VAT tax returns.

New dates and places will be announced in the BBK-Krant (BBK-Paper) and on our website.

The course contains an extensive written manual including tasks and exercises.
